

Bio

After studying at the Bordeaux School of Fine Arts, some thirty years ago, I faced the need to earn a living. My classmates chose teaching work, and city life, but I, to the dismay of my teachers, decided to return to the Landes region to work in the forest, following the family tradition.

That was a hard shock! Landscape painting was laid aside, to get up at 5 a.m. to work alongside loggers and truckies, applying highly mechanized violence to row after row of pine trees. We were making and remaking the landscape. Machines were tearing up hectares at a time, as far as the eye could see. A panorama of huge flat planes was unfolding before my eyes, like a painting by Nicolas de Staël.

Such a canvas is not composed freehand: every line is traced over from an underlying drawing, the cadastral records. The landscape is the third dimension of an administrative blueprint. My job was to use maps and compass to find manifestations of that cadastral matrix below the surface: the boundaries, marked in various ways. There were survey pegs, but also squared stones, and debarked trees, resembling primitive sculptures.

I worked for a big paper company, harvesting thousands of tons of wood throughout the Aquitaine region. It was tempting to divert one or two logs from this process ... and that's how I got into sculpture. I got into wood. Wood is not marble or clay -- wood is alive, wood has a grain.

I was drawn to the way indigenous peoples produce carvings that resemble and represent, without being a faithful likeness. The Cubists, in their own way, tried to emulate this feat by putting the front and side of their model on the canvas. In fact, it is as if the original form already exists within the wood. The sculptor's work is to uncover it. The model, whether human or animal, is merely a representation of the original form hiding in the wood. As if, in a kind of reversal, it is not the sculpture that resembles the model, but the model that resembles the sculpture.
